Campuses & Centers - What's the difference?

8 Campus Libraries: Each ACC campus has a full service Library complete with books, journals, Librarians, reserves, ITV resources, services, etc. ACC students may use any ACC campus library.

4 Centers Library Services: Four ACC Centers have Library staff on-site, but have limited hours and resources as compared to Campus Libraries.

Ask the Library staff at these 4 Centers for

assistance -- they connect you to the full variety of Library services & resources.

Are available at ACC campus Media Centers. The 4 Centers – have a limited variety. Contact the 4 Centers for availability at those locations.

Article Databases:

Journal & magazine articles are indexed in ACC Library databases – including access to **full-text articles**. See the list of databases at -- http://alicat.austincc.edu/screens/srchhelp_y.html

These full-text resources, as well as other e-resources, are accessible from the 4 Centers, as well as remotely from anywhere you have Internet access.

Remote Access to Library Databases:

When connecting to Library article databases from home -- you are prompted to identify yourself as an ACC student or employee.

You will be prompted to enter your

- **ACCeID** (which is your ACC ID # preceded by first name initial).
- And a password that you create.

Hints:

- *ACCeID is the same log-in as used for BlackBoard.*
- *Students can find ID numbers on registration & payment statements.*
